
Our research team presents a research project "History of Russian Psychology in Persons" and a journal "History of Russian Psychology in Persons: Digest".

The aim of this project is the search and systematization of historical and biographical facts in the history of Russian psychology.

The concept of "Russian psychology" has a broad meaning, considering an all historical and psychological facts that have different degrees of relationship to psychology in Russia (territorial, biographical, etc.) during pre-Soviet, Soviet and post-Soviet era.

Principles of the research project "History of Russian Psychology in Persons":

- 1. All published materials are based on literary, historical and archival sources.
- 2. Information article about a scientist on the history of Russian psychology consists of the following sections: the authors of information articles, biography, necropolis, research fields, scientific contributions, bibliography, photos, map of the Russian history of psychology in persons, references, categories of article.
- 3. The author of the information article about scientisits can be any specialist who has both unpublished information about the scientist and published one. To do this, one can contact the research team of the project and discuss the options for publishing material (see below Journal Publishing Activity Policy).
- 4. Search for materials on the scientists is carried out through the study of scientific, literary, historical and archival sources. References to each source must be indicated at the end of the information article.
- 5. The systematization of materials is carried out on the project site while keeping the authorship of materials, or by specifying the bibliographic references that were used in the preparation of the information article.
- 6. A map of the history of Russian psychology is the map of places of birth, study, work, immigration, internshio, exiles, death of all scientists who were involved in the history of Russian psychology.

Journal Publishing Activity Policy

- 1. The journal publishes relevant historical and psychological researches in the framework of the project. Articles published in the journal contain the currently known materials on the biography and scientific activity of scientists-psychologists, as well as newly discovered facts and information (in this case, the paper contains only new data and published without the main information article on the personality). The journal is a tool for notification of the results of the current state and researches of the history of Russian psychology.
- 2. Journal sections are the same as in the information article: Biography, Bibliography, Necropolis, Scientific Contributions, Pictures.
- 3. The journal accepts articles based on two types of historical and psychological materials published and unpublished.
- A) If the material has been previously published in monographs, journals, conferences and collections of articles, the author provides a review of these materials (in order to not to violate copyrights), pointing in the reference list the sources that have been used when writing the article;
- B) If the submitting materials have not been published, the author creates an article on your own. However, if the author wants to publish material from private archives (photographs, letters, diaries, documents), it is required to resolve the issue with the rights holders.
